September has arrived, and school is back in session!

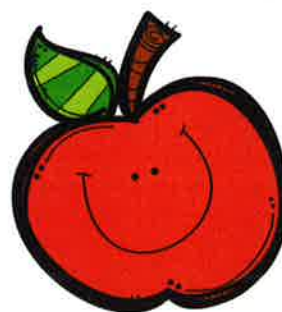

We are preparing for administration of the annual influenza vaccination for Four Winds Manor and Lodge residents. Our facility offers influenza vaccines to all residents (unless there is a significant allergic reaction) starting in October. Staff will be vaccinated prior to resident vaccinations. You can anticipate the risk/benefit information for the 2017-18 Inactivated Influenza Vaccine to be included with your billing information for September.
